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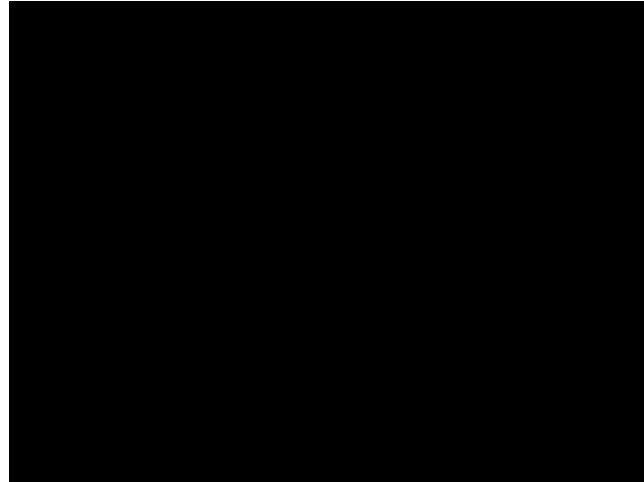

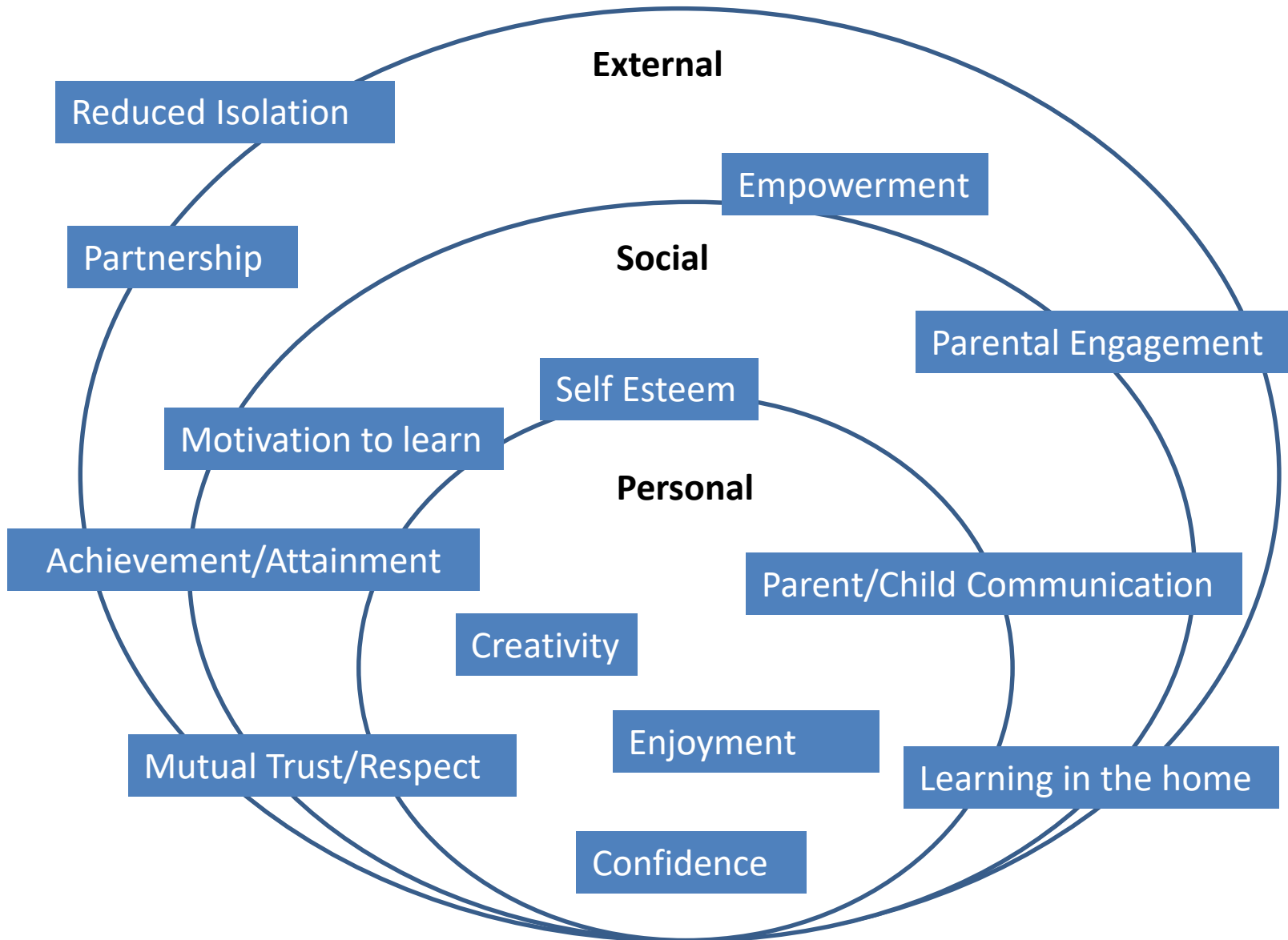

'I joined the Parent Council, never felt confident enough before these groups, and thought it was for those and such as those.'

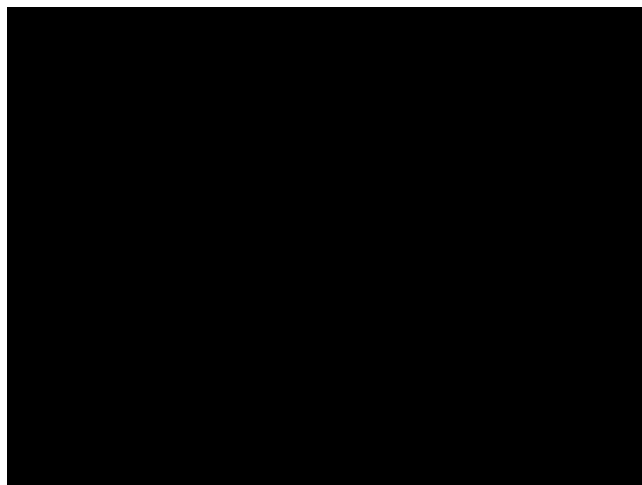
'I enjoyed the Maths so much and wanted to help my daughter, so went on to College to learn National 5 Maths".
