



## What other work is happening that this work could help with?

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There are lots of groups and organisations in Scotland whose job it is to think about different parts of education in Scotland. Angela has some suggestions for some of these groups about how what they have found out could be useful for others.



### **Recommendation: Curriculum for Excellence**

- ☆ There are plans to review the Curriculum for Excellence (the plan for what children and young people learn about). That review should think about what Angela has found out and what children and young people with additional support needs need from the curriculum.
- ☆ The review of the Curriculum for Excellence should focus on the experiences of children, young people, their families and the adults that work with them.



### **Recommendation: The Scottish Education Council**

- ☆ The Scottish Education Council is in charge of making sure things are improving in education in Scotland. They should use what Angela has found out to help them do this.



### **Recommendation: Relationships and Behaviour**

- ☆ There is a group of people who look at relationships, behaviour and bullying in schools in Scotland. It is important that they look at all of the information that will help, including what Angela has found out in this review. They should think about who the best people to be part of this group are.
